

WEDDING GUIDELINES

First Baptist Roswell

Non-member weddings cannot be reserved on the Church calendar until nine (9) months prior to the wedding date.

Weddings are performed by one of our ministers on staff or a guest minister who is approved by our wedding committee.

Weddings will not be scheduled that conflict with any worship service or event involving the membership as a whole. Weddings cannot be scheduled on Sundays, or holiday weekends (New Year's, Palm Sunday, Easter, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Memorial Day) without approval of the wedding committee.

Two weddings can be scheduled on the same day if there will be no conflict with ceremonies and rehearsals and allowing a 6 hour time period between ceremonies.

Weddings may be held on a Friday or Saturday and scheduled to begin no later than 6:30 p.m.

Rehearsals will be scheduled on the day prior to the wedding between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

After date is secured on the Church calendar, our Wedding Director will schedule a meeting with the bride and groom to discuss all regulations, guidelines and procedures.
