

Preschool Curriculum – Fours

1. Recognize and write alphabet – upper and lower case.
2. Phonics – sounding out of consonants and vowels.
3. Recognize and write numbers – 1-20.
4. Review colors and shapes.
5. Learn to follow oral directions.
6. Recite Pledge of Allegiance, Lord's Prayer, Ten Commandments, and blessings.
7. Share orally in group discussions.
8. Study different units such as: All About Me, Left & Right, Rhyming & Patterning, Opposites, Time & Money, 5 Senses, Logical Thinking (sequencing), Life Cycles, Transportation, Dinosaurs, Holidays, Seasons.
9. Work on recalling facts from stories read orally.
10. Learn what rhyming means and how to differentiate rhyming words.
11. Introduce sight words (Dolch Pre-Primer).
12. Learn to recognize basic color words.
13. Write first name (Upper and Lower Case). Recognize last name.
14. Daily calendar (months, days of the week) and weather.
15. Daily Circle Time – Bible Story, Story Time, group discussions, math games, Brainquest, flashcards.
16. Spanish – Once weekly, 20 minutes.
17. Computer – Once weekly (Introduction to Computer Skills)
18. Music – Monday – Friday, 30 minutes.
19. Daily recess time – 30 minutes
20. Counting to 100 (1's, 5's & 10's).
21. Simple Math – more and less than, addition and subtraction.
22. Money – recognize and worth.
23. Address & Phone Number
24. Participate in organized play.
