Roswell First Baptist Curriculum (Three-Year Olds)

The three-year curriculum will include a variety of learning activities relating to the alphabet, colors, shapes, nursery rhymes and various themes. To develop fine motor skills we will use scissors, play dough, puzzles, threading (large beads and pasta), blocks and painting (we use the easel and alternate with large and small brushes). To develop gross motor skills we encourage running, climbing and ball playing, kicking, rolling and throwing. We develop social skills by sharing, cooperating, taking turns, showing interest in others and communicating effectively.

Our objectives are for your child to:

- . Work and play in harmony
- . Recognize letters of the alphabet, shapes and colors
- . Count objects 1-10
- . Cut shapes and objects for various activities
- . Recognize and print name
