

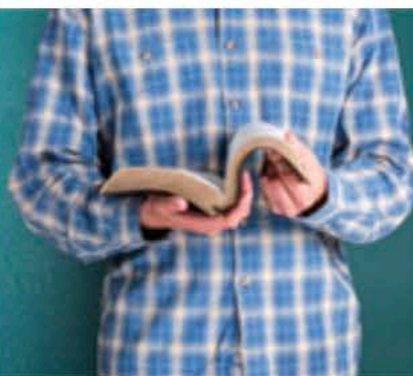
MORE INFORMATION
