Sunday school classes meet each week at 9:45AM throughout our building. We want every class to be a place of **Growth** and **Belonging**.

Growth: All of us are called to journey in our Christian faith and grow in our relationship with God. Each week our Sunday morning Bible study classes meet to study scripture and apply it to our lives.

Belonging: We do not live out our faith alone, but rather in relationship with one another. Our classes are a place where your name is known, where you are missed if you're gone, and where you can share life with others.

Adult Classes

▶ **Bo Buice** - Room 211

Named in honor of Bo Buice, our first ordained female deacon, who envisioned and launched this class for singles and couples 50+ in age. Lessons are scripture based. Assembly starts with a hymn, praises and prayer requests. With various committees -- Social, Christmas, Inreach and Outreach -- there is a place for everyone to be involved. This class is an extended family exemplifying God's love, celebrating together, supporting each other; a caring, warm group of Christians that welcomes all, never too old to learn more about God's amazing grace. ▶ **Circle Makers** - Garden Terrace 3B

The Circle Makers class is a mixture of couples and singles ranging from 45-60, with many having kids currently in college or starting young adult life. Video studies and Bible-based discussions are used in class each week. This is the perfect class for anyone looking for a place to fit in! Taught by Tiffany Ray and Winston Nuckolls.

▶ **Coffee and Conversation** - Room E353A

Everyone has a voice in this group that is heavily based on conversation over lecture. There is vibrant, spirited conversation with a hope for deepened relationships and a desire to know God more intimately. Come grab a cup of coffee and join the conversation! Taught by Nathan Jones.

▶ **College & Career** - Parlor (310)

This class is composed of college students and young professionals from 18-30. They are a lively, caring group that regularly focuses on scripture and topics applicable to the young adult's life. Taught by Tonya Corbett and her noted sidekick, Larry Corbett.

▶ **Cornerstone** - Room E350

This class is comprised mostly of parents of teenagers. Its laid-back atmosphere welcomes all, and there is a strong focus on bringing the Bible to life by breaking down a single passage of scripture, going through it verse by verse, and applying it to daily life. Class members keep up with each other through weekly emails of praises, prayer requests and announcements. Taught by Steven Butler, former stand-up comedian.

▶ **Encouragers** - Room 207

A women's Bible study class that cares for and prays for one another regularly. This group hopes to learn about the Lord through Bible study, as they support each other in growing and maturing in faith. Social times outside of class happen once a quarter, and when there is a need in class they look for ways to support and encourage each other. Taught by Anita Thibeault.

▶ **Faithful Friends** - Room 210

This lively senior adult class has three rotating teachers and lessons are strictly Bible-based. They love to eat together, hug and affirm each other, and care for one another when sick or going through difficult times. They keep up with each other regularly through email and class get-togethers. Taught by Wallace Faulkner, Nancy Harper and Bill Roland.

▶ **Fellowship** - Garden Terrace 2

A senior adult class that prides itself on being incredibly warm and friendly, this class has no regular teacher... and doesn't want one. They have food and start with a hymn, then enjoy hearing new perspectives from different teachers each week. Using Lifeway's Exploring the Bible, they explore scripture in depth by moving through one book of the Bible at a time. Taught by rotating teachers.

▶ **Fishers of Men** - Room 205


A small group of men aged 65+ with open discussion and rotating teachers. Those in the group enjoy fellowship and talking about matters pertinent to Christian men today. Taught by members of the class, facilitated by Don White.

▶ **Friendship** - Room 316 (Chapel Bldg)

This group of senior adult women's ages range from the 70s to the 90s. They have a wonderful spirit in the room and have rotating teachers who lead the 8-10 attendees through expositional Bible study each week. These women support, care and pray for one another. Taught by rotating teachers, facilitated by Dora Freeman.

▶ **Gap Class** - Room E260

A small group composed of couples and singles in their 60s-70s, using the Smith & Helwys curriculum to look deep into the Bible and see how it applies to our life today. The group enjoys fellowship with each other over food each week before class. Taught by Keith Patton.



▶ **Good News Class** - Room E357

The Good News class is composed mostly of folks in their 50s-70s, some working and some retired, with lessons coming straight out of scripture each week. They begin each Sunday with food and prayer requests, and have formed tight relationships in their group. Plan to visit if you are interested in hearing the Good News! Taught by Bill Holcomb.

▶ **Grace** - Room 201

A discussion-based class, with mostly retired folks, that tends to appeal to people who are interested in being challenged and are open to a wider theological perspective. The class studies books of the Bible with discussions centered around questions that are on the minds of Christians today and how the Bible informs our lives. This class regularly eats lunch together and enjoys frequent get-togethers, like movie nights. Taught by rotating teachers, coordinated by Bob Blankenship, Arnold Eaves, and Jack Grisham.

▶ **In His Name** - Room 202

This class is composed mostly of folks in their 50s-70s. The teaching is both straightforward and humorous, as ample time is spent working through a book of the Bible. Class members fellowship together over breakfast, share praises and prayer requests each week, and have a heart for the missions of First Baptist Roswell. Taught by Steve Ivey.

▶ **Journey** - Room E351

Newly formed in 2019, this class is comprised mostly of single and married folks in their 20s and 30s. It's a fun, conversational atmosphere with both expositional and topical Bible studies. Members get together quarterly for fellowship and keep up with one another throughout the week. Rotating teachers include Christy Carpenter and Marc & Penny Walley.

▶ **Seekers** - Room E356

A small group of folks ranging from 40s to 60s that enjoys being together and uses a variety of curriculum options for lessons and discussion. This class wants to know one another on a personal level and share life together in deep ways. All are invited to join. Taught by David Sholl.

▶ **Seymour/Moore-Joy** - Garden Terrace 3A

This small group of senior adult ladies loves to see each other each week for Bible study and fellowship. They are mostly single/widowed and give each other support throughout the week as they visit and call one another, especially when one member is going through difficult times. Taught by Margaret Elton.

▶ **Thee Class** - Room E352

Thee Class includes adults in middle life and beyond, both couples and singles. The class is taught in a discussion-based format using BaptistWay Press literature to study scripture. The class cares for one another and embraces different viewpoints -- all questions and comments are welcome! Taught by Mark Armentrout.

▶ **Women of Worship** - Room E259

A small group of women ranging from 40s to 70s who love each other and come from all walks of life. Some are working, others are retired. They are married and divorced, single and widowed, but all enjoy being together for Bible study using the Formations curriculum. Taught by Marilyn Wagner.
