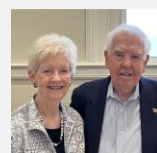

Celebration of Holy Communion

Unique to our World Communion worship experience today, we represent, honor, and remember two additional regions of the global church during communion: Kenya and Uganda, and Ukraine. As you partake from the bread plate passed down your row, you'll notice there are pieces of three types of bread: our usual communion bread pieces representing the United States, East African chapati representing Kenya and Uganda, and rye bread representing Ukraine. We invite you to take only one piece of bread from plate. As you do so, reflect on the people the piece of bread you chose represents, and remember in prayer our fellow believers around the world practicing communion alongside us today. (For those with a gluten allergy or sensitivity, the Ukrainian rye bread option is gluten free.)
