Worship Words

As you continue in this journey through Lent, perhaps you feel the tension building through the wilderness of the season. Perhaps you feel the deepening and growing weight of this time as you look inward - as we confess the barriers from our sin that come between us and God. The weight of this transformative season can become quite heavy. We realize that without God’s power, without Jesus’ love, and without strength from the Holy Spirit, we are helpless. But thanks be to God that in this time of pause, we, hopefully, come to realize our need of God. Not just as a divine being who caused deity over the cause of our life and creation, but as a constant presence in our everyday ebb and flow of our goings and comings, our doings and sayings, all the happenings of our lives. If we didn’t need God, the glory and praise would be for us. Yet, because of Jesus’ love for us, God exalted him and placed him above all - a bright beacon in the storm of life for us to find and place our hope and need in. As we worship today, might you remember that we need God, and if we place our lives at the feet of Jesus’ throne and in God’s hands, God will surely hold us fast and see us through to life anew that awaits us in Christ.

Narthex Display

On the fifth Sunday in Lent, the Narthex display takes us to Jesus’ trials. After His arrest, Jesus is taken to the Sanhedrin who are at the home of Caiaphas, the high priest. There He is placed in a dungeon, mocked, humiliated, struck, and spat upon by Soldiers. Then, He is sent to King Herod for trial where He is again mocked and humiliated before being sent back to Pilate. Pilate orders Him to be scourged, adorned with a crown of thorns, robed, and mocked as a king. Our Lord willingly endured this horrendous physical and emotional suffering and deep humiliation for us; a sacrifice we can never repay. We are reminded in the display of the incredible love Jesus has for us as He continues His journey to the cross.
