Denominational Emphasis Report from Church Conference Sunday, April 28, 2024

The following Resolution was proposed and adopted by vote of the conference as a statement of our identity and an affirmation of our ministers past, present, and future:

"The First Baptist Church of Roswell has been serving the Lord in Roswell, Georgia for over 150 years. We are a Great Commission church, sharing the Word of God and the love of Jesus Christ in Roswell, the Southeast, throughout North America, and around the world. We have a long history of supporting the Southern Baptist Convention functionally, financially, and prayerfully. We have and will continue to affirm the gifts of God and the calling of God to men and women in vocational ministry and lay leadership. Over the past 30 years we have ordained several women to gospel ministry and have two on our staff today. We have ordained many women to the diaconate. As an autonomous congregation led by Scripture under the Lordship of Christ, we celebrate and affirm each of these women to the calling God has given them."
