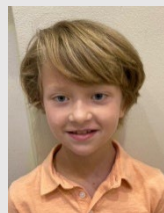

The rose on the platform today is placed in honor of Reagan Ann Fennell, born September 3, 2024, to Macy and Matt Fennell.




